Columbia Land Trust conserves and cares for the Northwest lands, waters, and wildlife we love. Our work covers a vast stretch of the Columbia River region, from the John Day to the Pacific coast. Our approach is based on sound science and strong relationships, and it has helped us become one of the most respected and recognized land trusts in the country.

To date we've conserved more than 32,000 acres and have over 4,000 supporters. Our work region covers two states (Oregon and Washington) and 13,760 square miles around the Columbia River and its many tributaries.

Our conservation projects range from removing outdated infrastructure to restore river floodplains to returning forestland to historic conditions to reconnecting tidal wetlands – all of which help wildlife and habitat thrive for generations to come.
